During the nearly thirty years of teaching piano at the university level, Martín Cuéllar has enjoyed an active career as performer, educator, clinician, and composer. He holds degrees in piano performance from *The University of Texas at Austin* (DMA, MM) and *The Royal Conservatory of Music* in Madrid, Spain (performance certificate) where he studied as a Rotary Scholar. Dr. Cuéllar has also conducted research and piano studies on the music of Enrique Granados at the *Marshall Academy of Music* in Barcelona (formerly the *Granados Academy*).

As a performer, Martín has played concerts in the United States, Mexico, Brazil, Bolivia, Paraguay, Spain, Germany, South Korea, and China. He is also nationally recognized as a composer of pedagogical piano pieces and is published by the FJH Music Company -- publisher of not only his pedagogical compositions, but academic editions as well.

Martín retired from full-time teaching in December 2022 as Professor Emeritus of Piano, Emporia State University, Emporia, KS. Since spring 2023 Dr. Cuéllar has divided his time between teaching privately in Orlando, FL and various schools in China (ZheJiang Province). He continues to maintain an active schedule of scholarly research, performances, master classes, and teaching both at home and abroad.
